



Volunteer Engagement in Skilled Nursing Facilities

Participation Agreement

We would like to join the California Association of Health Facilities (CAHF) Volunteer Engagement Project. This project will provide a framework for facilities to engage their community and create a successful and sustainable volunteer program to enhance the quality of life for skilled nursing facility residents.

Beginning in July 2018, the project will span two and a half years and enroll 20 skilled nursing facilities in California. **As a participating facility, we will receive two site visits and support from CAHF project staff for up to one year to help us identify effective positive person-centered practices that can be supported by volunteers in our community.**

As a participating facility, we will agree to:

- Work with CAHF project staff to discuss previous volunteer participation and challenges in our facility
- Help to identify areas of person-centered care that would benefit from a strong volunteer program
- Allow CAHF project staff to review our Facility Assessment and Policy and Procedures to identify references to volunteer training and inclusion
- Provide one employee (usually the Activity Director or Volunteer Coordinator) to be available to CAHF project staff for periodic check-in, support, and problem-solving calls
- Track all volunteer participation using our QAPI for the duration of the project, ending in December 2020
