We would like to join the California Association of Health Facilities (CAHF) Volunteer Engagement Project. - Allow CAHF project staff to review our Facility Assessment and Policy and Procedures to identify references to volunteer training and inclusion
- Provide one employee (usually the Activity Director or Volunteer Coordinator) to be available to CAHF project staff for periodic check-in, support, and problem-solving calls
- Track all volunteer participation using our QAPI for the duration of the project, ending in December 2020
