



Our Vision: As part of the California Health and Human Services Agency, our vision is to promote **Equitable Healthcare Accessibility for California.**

Healthcare Facilities (Facilities Development Division) - In support of its mission of equitable healthcare accessibility for California, the Office provides timely, accurate, and actionable information on California's healthcare infrastructure; works to ensure that patients in hospitals and long-term care facilities are safe in the event of an earthquake or other disaster; and insures low interest loans for public and non-profit healthcare facilities at no cost to the state.

Cal-Mortgage is a Division of the Office of Statewide Health Planning and Development (OSHPD). Cal-Mortgage administers the California Health Facility Construction Loan Insurance Program (Program). Cal-Mortgage provides credit enhancement for eligible health care facilities when they borrow money for capital needs. Cal-Mortgage insured loans are guaranteed by the "full faith and credit" of the State of California. This guarantee permits borrowers to obtain lower interest rates, similar to the rates received by the State of California.

Healthcare Workforce Division – The Office strives to increase the supply of culturally competent healthcare providers practicing in medically underserved areas of California. The Office administers and partners with several programs designed to improve the number and diversity of students seeking careers in the health professions, thereby increasing access to healthcare for all Californians.

The **Healthcare Information Division** (HID) administers the databases that are the foundation of OSHPD's information products. HID collects data from all licensed health facilities in California and ensures the accuracy and confidentiality of the data. HID collects Patient, Facility Utilization, and Hospital Financial data. These data are made available through a wide variety of information products at our www site.
