**SUBJECT: Issue Alert: MDS 3.0 NH Provider and MDS 3.0 SB Provider Reports
Temporarily Disabled**

The reports in the MDS 3.0 NH Provider and MDS 3.0 SB Provider report categories in the CASPER Reporting application have been disabled. The disabling of these reports will assist in the research of the connectivity issues currently impacting the QIES systems.

The following 14 reports from the above reporting categories have been temporarily disabled for states and providers:

- MDS 3.0 Admission/Reentry
- MDS 3.0 Assessment with Error Number XXXX
- MDS 3.0 Discharges
- MDS 3.0 Error Detail by Facility

The MDS 3.0 NH Provider and MDS 3.0 SB Provider report category links will remain available on CASPER Reports page; however, if the link is selected, no reports will display on the right side of the application window.

The reports identified above are the only reports that have been disabled. This does **not** impact the MDS 3.0 NH Final Validation, MDS 3.0 SB Final Validation, or MDS 3.0 Submitter Validation Reports. Providers, corporate, and third party users will still have access to these reports.

A follow up memo will be distributed when the reports are available to states and providers.
