Challenging Discharges

- Increase in complaints about evictions and discharges
- Federal law allows nursing homes to transfer or discharge a patient for "specific reasons"
- Coverage changes may have an impact on discharge plans
- Challenging behaviors may influence discharge
- OIG has become engaged in this issue
- Potential liability

Discharge Reasons

- Cannot provide adequate care for the resident
- Resident's health has improved to the point they no longer need NH care
- Safety of individuals in facility are endangered
- · Health of others in facility endangered
- Resident has failed to pay (not medicaid eligible)
- Facility ceases to operate

Discharge Planning

- NH must provide discharge planning and sufficient preparation
- Resident must participate in planning care and treatment
- NH should prepare an orientation to discharge location
- NH should assure that possessions aren't lost

- Specific discharge related goals MUST be set

Discharge Planning

- Does resident NEED NH level care?
- Do they have a SAFE discharge location?
- Documentation of plan
