





























## Improving Accuracy of the EMR while Giving **Nurses More Time with Residents**

- Taking & Recording of Vitals:
  Currently, nurses take vitals, record on paper, enter in EMR
  Errors in recording readings (Human Error)
  Additional time nurse is unable to spend with resident

  - New technology captures readings directly from vital device
    Eliminates need to record on paper and later enter in EMR
    Totally eliminates inaccuracy or vitals in EMR
    Provides nursing staff additional time to spend in informal observation and interaction with residents
    In a 120 bed SNF, over 7 hours of nursing staff saved/day
  - For Residents, provides additional time with staff helping improve social interaction and fighting loneliness.
