Promoting overall long stay patient health and mobility is a priority of California SNFs.

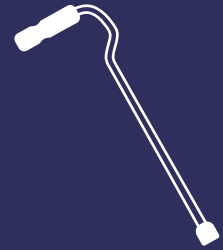
